

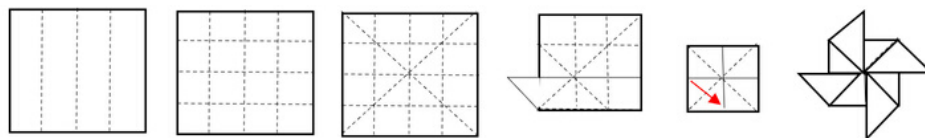
Make Your Own Origami Windmill

You Will Need

- Square piece of paper
- A paper fastener
- A straw with hole in the end
- Glue stick
- Colouring pencils



How To Make

1. Fold the square paper in half by aligning opposite sides together and unfold
2. Then fold the outside lines inward to the half way line so the page is folded into quarters and unfold
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 for the opposite direction
4. Fold the square paper in half by aligning the opposite corners and unfold
5. Repeat this for the other two corners as well
6. Fold two quarter line pieces inwards as shown in picture four, so that one corner is sticking out. Bring the corner of this piece to the center and fold downwards
7. Do this with each of the four corners
8. Then, once each of the four small squares are folded inwards, pull one corner over to the other as shown by the red arrow. Do not flatten fully to allow wind to be caught by the design.
9. Fasten your pinwheel to your straw using the paper fastener.

See wind energy in action by blowing hard on your windmill or make it turn. Or stand outside and watch the power of wind rotate your windmill.
